

PHOTO IDENTIFICATION POLICY

PRACTICE TO BE APPLIED

PRACTICE

All players from the 18's Grade to the Premier Grade are required to have CRL photo ID before they can take the field for any competition game.

The process to be applied for the checking of the cards is:

- 1. Team cards must be completed 10 (ten) minutes prior to the commencement of the game.
- 2. Players must assemble on the halfway line 5 minutes prior to the commencement of the game.
- 3. Managers will cross reference the players ID against the player and the team card.
- 4. If the opposition manager agrees the entries on the team cards to be true and correct the opposition manager will sign the team card. If there are any discrepancies the opposition manager will advise the manager they will not sign the card and will refer the matter to CRL.
 It is important to note that once a team card is signed by both managers the team card entries are not open to protest.
- 5. Should a player not be able to produce a CRL photo ID the player will be declared an Out of Order player and will not be able to play in the game. On occasion where this occurs the players name must be removed from the team card.
- 6. Should a Coach and/or Manager allow a player to play in a game without the appropriate CRL ID the Coach and/or Manager will be required to appear in front of a Disciplinary Tribunal.

These Procedures are to be read in conjunction with the Canterbury Rugby League By Laws.
