

CRL Sideline Behaviour Management Process

- 1. CRL to implement <u>NZRL Be a Sport Just Support Process</u> for all Men's Premier and Premier Reserves games.
- 2. Clubs to nominate BAS Team Champions (Premier home teams x 2, away teams x1, Premier Bs x1 each). Please see recommendations below.
- 3. Clubs to place Be a Sport sandwich boards on each field prior to match(es).
- 4. 15 minutes prior to kick off, Team Champions meet the BAS Manager (Match Manager) at the Match Manager table to discuss responsibilities and expectations.
- 5. In an instance where clubs have not appointed a Team Champion, the match shall not commence.
- 6. During the game the BAS process along with CRL's Safety Plan is in action.

Escalating Inappropriate Behaviour

- Escalating inappropriate behaviour includes but is not limited to; repetitive verbal abuse targeted towards a match official. Verbal abuse is use of words to assault, dominate, ridicule, manipulate, and/or degrade another person and negatively impact that person's psychological health.
- In instances of escalating inappropriate behaviour (BAS Step 4 6), a referee may choose to call time off during the match to inform the BAS Manager (Match Manager) of any sideline behaviour issues.
- Likewise, to above, in instances of escalating inappropriate behaviour (BAS Step 4 6) a BAS Manager (Match Manager) may choose to get the attention of a referee to call time off during the match to address any sideline behaviour issues.
- If inappropriate sideline behaviour continues, the BAS Manager (Match Manager) and referee will discuss with each team's coach and captain any final measures and determine whether the game will continue.

Recommendations

- CRL recommend, where possible, clubs to allocate one female Team Champion and one male Team Champion for premier home games.
- Clubs to identify members that will consistently uphold Team Champion roles and responsibilities as identified on page 2 of NZRL Be a Sport Just Support Process.
- Clubs to select Team Champions that are regularly in attendance for their games. This will help uphold the responsibilities and expectations of the Team Champion.
